Weekly Legislative Feature Issues:

This week at the Capitol saw committees continue meeting to take action on bills that were referred to them from other committees. Now that the Judiciary Committee's regular business concluded, the only two committees left to close are Appropriations (4/27) and Finance Revenue & Bonding (4/28). The 13 Appropriations sub-committees wrapped up their work last week and since then have been busy crafting the expenditures portion of what will become the legislature's budget proposal. The Finance Revenue & Bonding Committee has been similarly engaged. Their part of the legislature's budget- the revenue component- complementing that of Appropriations, is expected in the next two weeks. Additionally, this week also saw the House in session on Wednesday, April 12, 2017. They debated a number of bills over the course of the day and ended with HB No. 5591: AN ACT CONCERNING PAY EQUITY IN THE WORKFORCE. The bill was amended to consider gender wage discrimination under "similar" rather than "comparable" working conditions. Next week, the House expects to hold sessions on Wednesday (4/19) and Thursday (4/20).

2017 Legislative Session in the News:

Malloy plan hands poorest municipalities a life preserver and an anchor

Governor Malloy has indicated that he wants to help Hartford and Connecticut's poorest municipalities in stabilizing their local budgets while at the same time seeking to hold all municipalities liable for the payment of one-third of teacher pensions costs expected to explode over the next 15 years.

An analysis of the governor's budget found that five of the 20 poorest cities and towns in Connecticut face a net funding loss in the first or second years of the plan. The plan will benefit Hartford and Bridgeport significantly with hart receiving a net gain of \$47 million next fiscal year (after accounting for special education funding, Hartford's gain is closer to \$35 million) and Bridgeport is set to receive \$19.1 million ahead of next fiscal year. Other poor communities have immediate needs: Griswold, Mansfield, Plainfield, and Putnam are all set to lose funding under the governor's plan.

To solve these problems, Governor Malloy proposed changes in the Education Cost Sharing grant formula to increase funds for those communities most in need as well as making nonprofit hospitals' real property subject to local taxation.

Two legislative leaders proposing sweeping school funding changes

Senate Democratic Majority Leader, Senator Bob Duff and House Chair of the Finance, Revenue, and Bonding Committee, Rep. Jason Rojas are backing a plan to boost state spending for public schools by \$53 million next year. In addition, this plan will change how the state funds charter and magnet schools. This proposal uses the "how much high-achieving states spend" component of the "Breaking he Curve: Promises and Pitfalls of Using NAEP Data to Assess the State Role in Student Achievement" report by the Urban Institute. Senator Duff indicated that this will allow Connecticut to compare its efforts to other states and to see what they are doing better than us.

House speaker: tolls could be set up in 18 months.

On Wednesday, April 12, 2017, Speaker of the House Joe Aresimowicz said that toll legislation might be inserted into whatever budget bill is eventually improved or it could appear in a transit-related bill. House Majority Leader Matt Ritter remarked that "there's a lot of steps to it too." Speaker Aresimowicz commented that he "believe[s] that if we go about it in a strategic way, tolls could be up and running in a year-and-a half or so." The speaker did note that the federal government requires that an revenue from tolls must be reinvested in highway infrastructure and operations.
