Weekly Legislative Feature Issues:

Another week has passed and the legislative committees are beginning to wrap up their business. There are only 7 committees that will not have concluded their business by the end of this week, including the Judiciary, Appropriations, and Finance, Revenue & Bonding Committees. In addition, last Friday, the Transportation Committee voted along party lines 19-16 to pass HB No. 6058: AN ACT CONCERNING ELECTRONIC TOLLS out of the committee. This bill will now move forward for further action before the General Assembly. Moreover, the Appropriations Committee's subcommittees have been working diligently to develop the expenditure side of the legislative budget, while the Finance, Revenue, and Bonding Committee's General Bonding Subcommittee has begun meeting with executive agency representatives to hear about their bonding requests for the upcoming biennium

2017 Legislative Session in the News:

Some momentum builds for changes to education aid formula

Legislative leaders of the Education Committee, Senators Boucher and Slossberg and Representative Fleischmann would like to do an education cost study to determine what adequate funding for municipalities may look like. They want facts and data to back up the policy decisions they will make. Currently five other states, Arkansas, Kansas, Maryland, New Mexico and Pennsylvania, have engaged in studies. Governor Malloy and his State Department of Education Commissioner, Dianna Wentzell, disagree with this approach. The Governor's plan is to redistribute the existing funding from middle-income and wealthy communities to the state's more impoverished municipalities. Complicating the municipal budgeting process is another plan by the Governor which requires cities and towns to pick up one-third of teacher's pension costs. The Education Committee, which closes out for new business, known as their JF deadline, on Monday, March 27th, heard testimony on the various plans this past Monday.

Malloy says budget remains in balance, despite nonpartisan warning

Governor Dannel P. Malloy has stated that the current fiscal year will generate a \$22 million surplus, but the nonpartisan Office of Fiscal Analysis has advised that declining income tax receipts have generated a \$65 million deficit. The Office of Policy and Management (OPM) Secretary Ben Barnes acknowledges the importance of post-tax day receipts in truing up the budget for the 2016 – 2017 fiscal year, which concludes on June 30th. OPM Secretary Barnes continues to regard his January forecast as accurate in regards to a surplus. Among other factors, budget projections rely on changes in the economy and expenditure patterns. While the revenue side of the equation is the most challenging for the state, the expenditure side is currently running about \$11 million over budget. As we move closer to tax day, April 15th, there will be reports again coming from the Office of Fiscal Analysis next week and Comptroller Kevin Lembo is expected to weigh in with his projections on April 1st.

Proponents Argue That Tolling is The Only Way Left to Fund Crumbling Highways

Everyone knows the road and bridge infrastructure in the state is in peril. Without a credible funding source, the special transportation fund will become insolvent in 2021 and 2022. Enter electronic tolling legislation. The Transportation Committee last Friday voted to implement tolling on Connecticut's highways by a vote of 19 to 16. The legislation is also supposed to reduce the state gas tax by 2.5 cents over 5 years. Yet the initiative may already be too late to stave off insolvency. The proposal would return tolls to the state for the first time since the early 1980s when a horrific accident on Interstate 95 hastened their removal. Instead of stopping to pay, tolls are collected electronically by overhead gantries on the highway. Permission has already been received from the Federal Highway Administration. An electronic tolling system is currently being used in neighboring Massachusetts on Interstate 90. The state gas tax, the traditional funding mechanism, has fallen short, due in part to increased efficiency in automobiles and lower fuel prices. Dedicating the funds collected from electronic tolling to the highway fund is a critical component to making the system work.
