

**RESOLUTION OF THE CAPITOL REGION COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS
AUTHORIZING THE CRCOG EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR TO ACCEPT FUNDS FOR
PUBLIC HEALTH AND MEDICAL SERVICES PREPAREDNESS**

WHEREAS, CRCOG has previously received grant funds from the US Department of Health and Human Services for Public Health and Medical Services emergency preparedness through the Connecticut Department of Public Health; and

WHEREAS, these funds have been used to establish and enhance the Region 3 Emergency Support Function 8 – Public Health and Medical Services (R-3 ESF-8) to better prepare the Capitol Region to prepare for, respond to, and recover from public health emergencies and Mass Casualty Incidents; and

WHEREAS, the Connecticut Department of Public Health has identified the Region 3 ESF-8 as the healthcare coalition for the Capitol Region; and

WHEREAS, the Connecticut Department of Public Health has further identified the Capitol Region Council of Governments as the fiduciary to receive these grant funds; and

WHEREAS, the Connecticut Department of Public Health will be issuing grant awards to each of Connecticut's five emergency planning regions for Ebola and infectious disease preparedness to enhance all phases of emergency management for infectious disease outbreaks; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT, the Policy Board of the Capitol Region Council of Governments authorize the Executive Director to enter into an agreement with the Connecticut Department of Public Health to accept these funds and any additional funds to accomplish this planning.
