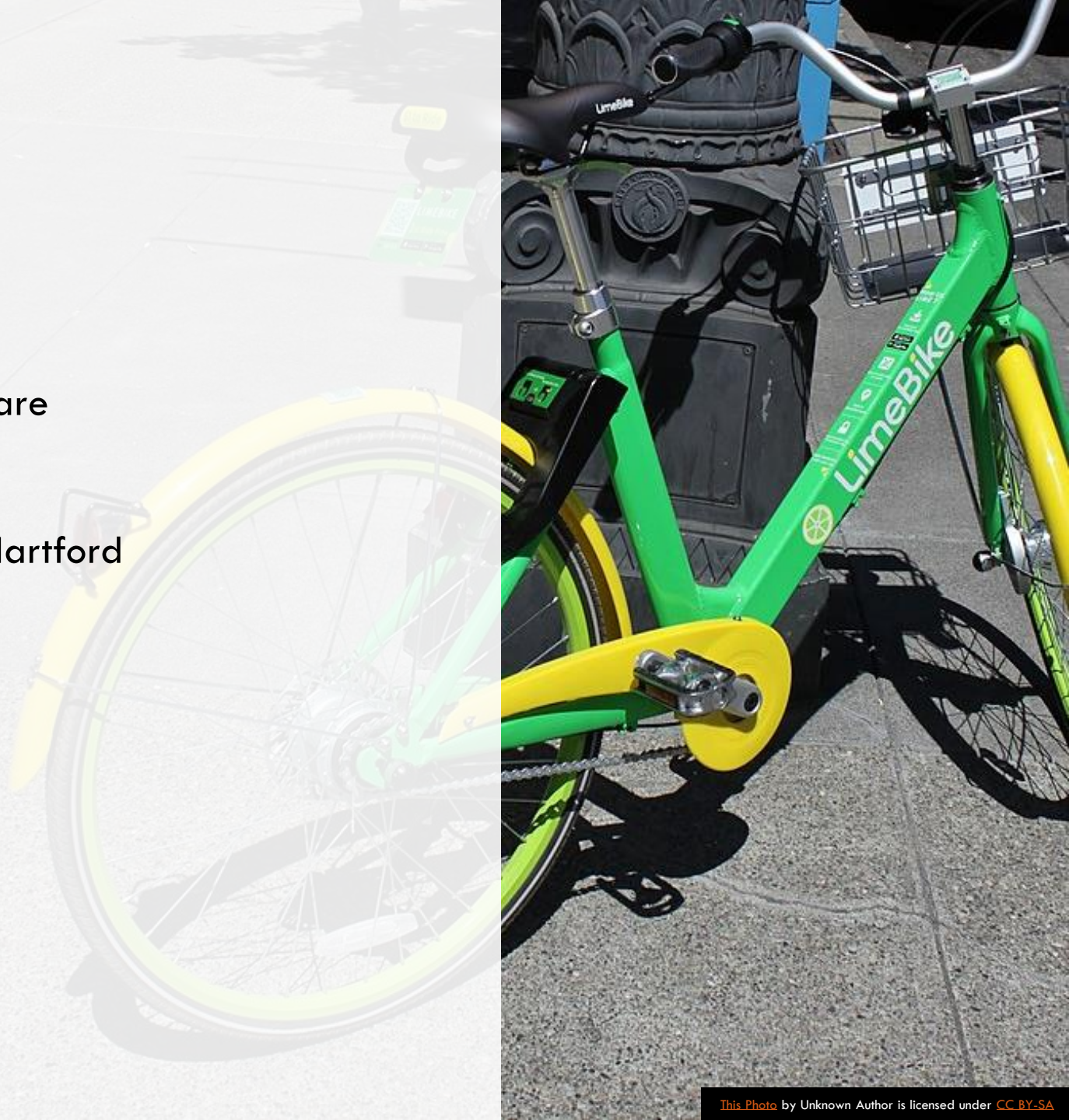

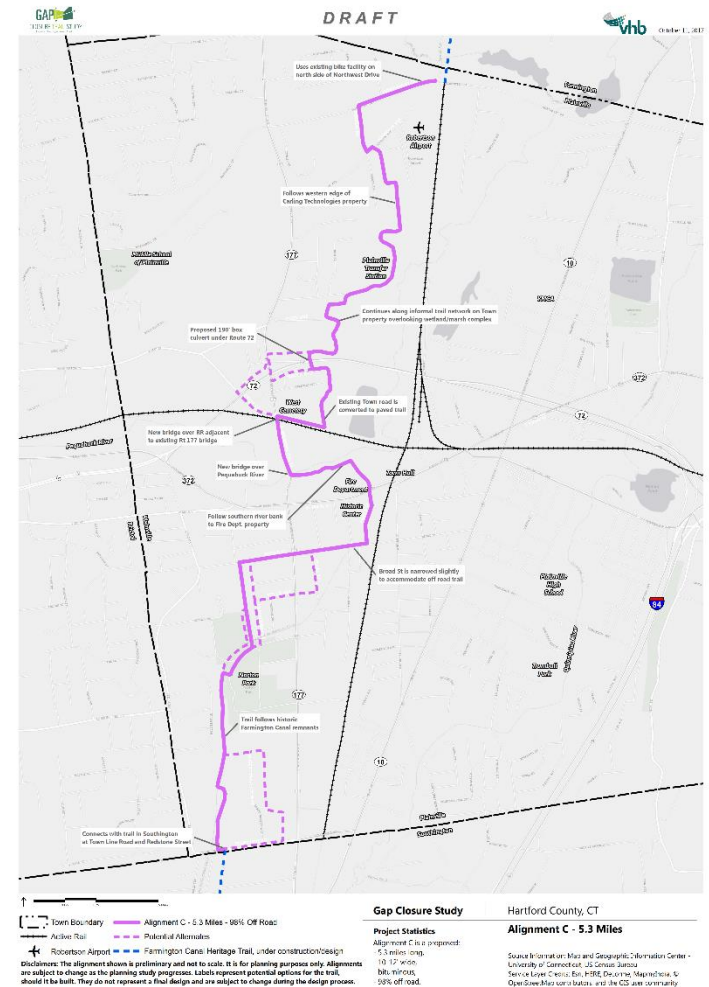
FUNDING OPPORTUNITIES
