

**Resolution Authorizing Execution of Agreement with
Cambridge Systematics, Inc. for Travel Demand Modeling and
Data Management Assistance**

WHEREAS, the Capitol Region Council of Governments (CRCOG) maintains a travel demand model for the Capitol Region; and

WHEREAS, CRCOG's travel demand model is an important tool in understanding future travel patterns and behaviors and was instrumental in forecasting ridership for CT **fastrak**; and

WHEREAS, CRCOG's recently vacated full-time modeling position created an opportunity to secure consultant assistance to complete assignments identified in CRCOG's Unified Planning Work Program (UPWP); and


WHEREAS, CRCOG has conducted a quality based selection process and found the consulting firm Cambridge Systematics, Inc. to be the most qualified firm for modeling and data management assignments; and

WHEREAS, CRCOG will be entering into fee negotiations with Cambridge Systematics, Inc., looking to have them assist with UPWP assignments at least 8 hours per week;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Agency's Executive Director Lyle D. Wray, is authorized to act on behalf of the Capitol Region Council of Governments in negotiating, executing, and amending all appropriate and necessary contractual instruments with the selected firm for the purposes of providing travel demand modeling and data management assistance.
