

CRCOG Bidder Questions & Answers
Electricity Procurement

Q1: Originally, the bid Announcement indicated accounts totaled 45 million kWh/year usage. The Data Exhibit says that there is 21 million kWh/year usage, and it was just verbally indicated that there is roughly 25 million kWh/year usage. What is the actual number?

A1: The 45 million kWh/year number was based on the previous procurement, but has since been updated as we pull data for the participating accounts. As of now, the data that has been returned indicates 21 million kWh/year usage, but we are awaiting data on a number of accounts and are hopeful that the number will rise. The final usage will be indicated in the final Data Exhibit.

Q2: Will the accounts be broken up into different tranches?

A2: The procurement strategy has not yet been finalized, but accounts may be broken up into different tranches. There will almost certainly be one tranche with all accounts included together.

Q3: When will the Q&A be posted?

A3: By Sep 27th.

Q4: Will billing addresses be provided before the auction?

A4: We will provide them as soon as we have them, but it may be after the auction.

Q5: Is there a billing preference between dual and consolidated billing?

A5: All participants prefer consolidated billing.

Q6: What is the contracting procedure, particularly regarding Side Letters?

A6: CRCOG has already collected signed Side Letters from all participants. On the day of contracting, CRCOG will send all Side Letters to the supplier for countersignature.
