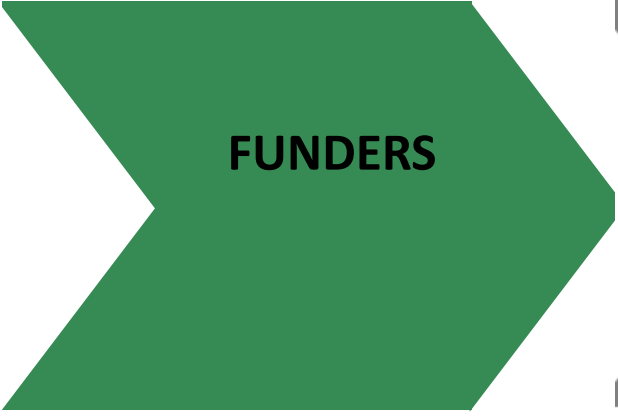

- **Livability.** More sustainable, efficient, healthy, safe, resilient, thriving municipalities.

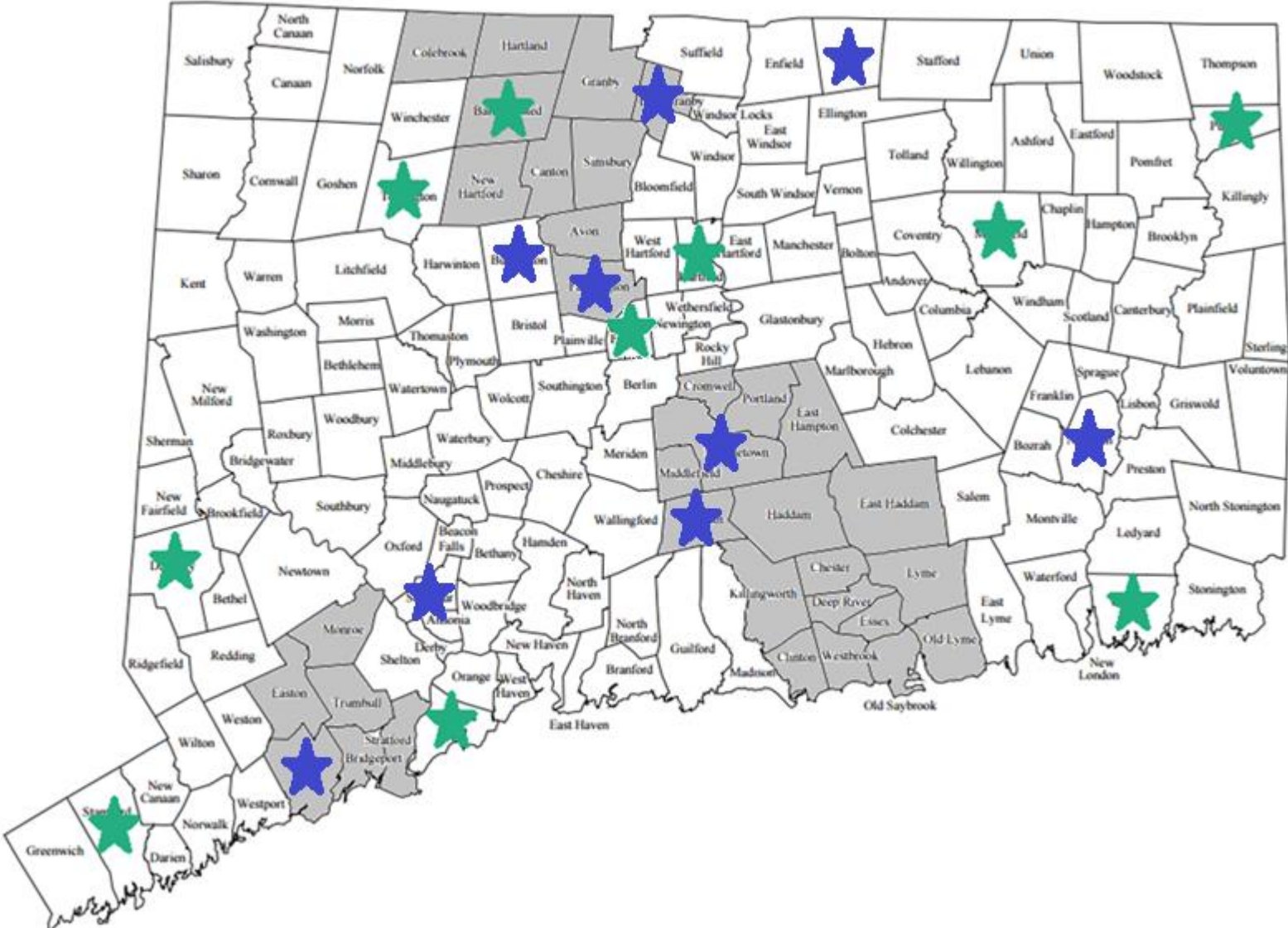

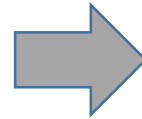
