Subject: Transportation Safety and Improvement Study: UConn Hartford Campus
Authorizing Resolution Adopting Final Study Report

Since 2016, CRCOG Staff has been working with a consultant and stakeholders to study and provide a palette of Transportation Safety and Improvement Options for the area surrounding the relocated UConn Hartford Branch Campus. The study focused on improvement options for “first and last mile connections” to and from the campus, including transit, biking, and walking (including walking between campus and transit stops/automobile parking areas). English and Spanish versions of a DRAFT report, dated August 2017, were shared with stakeholders, distributed, and made available on CRCOG’s website for a month long comment period. The availability of the DRAFT report and the comment period was also highlighted at the September Transportation Committee and Policy Board meetings.

The deadline for comments to receive full consideration was October 2nd, 2017. Following this period, CRCOG developed a Final Report, which is available in English and Spanish on the CRCOG website and can be accessed directly via the following links:
