
The Capitol Region Council of Governments has been asked to renew its appointment of a representative and alternate to serve on the Connecticut Resource Conservation and Development (RC&D) Council for a two-year term. On April 27, 2016, the CRCOG Policy Board authorized appointment of Lynne Pike DiSanto, Principal Planner and Policy Analyst as representative, and Mary Ellen Kowalewski, Director of Policy and Planning, as alternate, to fill this position. Lynne and Mary Ellen are willing to continue their service on the RC&D Council.

The Connecticut Resource Conservation and Development Program is a program of the United States Department of Agriculture. The RC&D is led by local volunteer councils, which include Regional Councils of Governments. The RC&D Council is an independent, non-profit, non-partisan corporation having as its primary missions the conservation and sound management of natural resources, sustainable development, and improved quality of life in the State of Connecticut. The RC&D carries out projects that help people care for and protect natural resources in a way that improves the local economy, environment and quality of life. An additional goal is to achieve a balance between rural economic development and natural resource protection. The RC&D is currently carrying out a number of programs and grants that need a full complement of members to help provide governance.

Resolved, that the Executive Committee of the Capitol Region Council of Governments appoints Lynne Pike DiSanto, Principal Planner and Policy Analyst to serve as representative, and Mary Ellen Kowalewski, Director of Policy and Planning, to serve as alternate representative from CRCOG to the Connecticut Resource Conservation and Development Council (CTRC&D). This appointment is for a two-year term, to begin on the first CTC&D meeting from the date of this appointment.
