

**RESOLUTION OF THE CAPITOL REGION COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS
AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR TO ACCEPT FUNDS FOR PUBLIC
HEALTH EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS (PHEP)**

WHEREAS, CRCOG has previously received grant funds from the US Department of Health and Human Services for Public Health Emergency Preparedness through the Connecticut Department of Public Health; and

WHEREAS, these PHEP funds have been used to establish and enhance the Region 3 Emergency Support Function 8 – Public Health and Medical Services to better prepare the Capitol Region to prepare for, respond to, and recover from public health emergencies and Mass Casualty Incidents; and

WHEREAS, the Connecticut Department of Public Health has identified the Capitol Region Council of Governments as the fiduciary to receive these grant funds on behalf of the local public health departments in our region; and


WHEREAS, as such, the Connecticut Department of Public Health has issued CRCOG Contract Award # 2019-0235 which has a contract period of 7/1/19 through 6/30/24; and

WHEREAS, CRCOG will act as the fiduciary agent and subcontract with the fourteen local public health agencies in Region 3 in order to complete the deliverables; and

WHEREAS, CRCOG will also receive funding for the Capitol Region Medical Reserve Corps for the purpose of providing medical direction, logistician services and training to the unit; and

WHEREAS, this funding will be in the amount of \$868,729 per year.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT, the Policy Board of the Capitol Region Council of Governments authorize the Executive Director to enter into an agreement with the Connecticut Department of Public Health to accept these funds and any addendums thereto and Administrative Service Agreements with the local public health agencies and any addendums thereto to accomplish this planning for the entire period of the contract award.
