Re: Southington Solar One, LLC Petition for Declaratory Ruling for a Solar Project to Be Located in Southington, Connecticut

Dear Sir/Madam:

Pursuant to section 16-50j-40(a) of the regulations of the Connecticut Siting Council (the "Council"), we are notifying you that Southington Solar One, LLC intends to file a petition for declaratory ruling with the Council on or shortly after July 27, 2020. This petition will request the Council's approval of the location and construction of a 4.725 megawatt alternating current ground-mounted solar photovoltaic system on an approximately 102.45 acre parcel of land in the Town of Southington, Connecticut ("the Project").

The Project is located in the south-central, eastern portion of Southington, on a parcel located at 1012 East Street. The parcel is on the west side of East Street, roughly a third of a mile (approximately 1,700 feet) south of Berlin Street (Route 364).

The Project consists of solar modules, string inverters, driven post racking, DC string wiring, AC wire runs, transformers, switchgear, metering equipment, security fencing and access roads. The Project will be interconnected with Eversource's electric distribution system.
