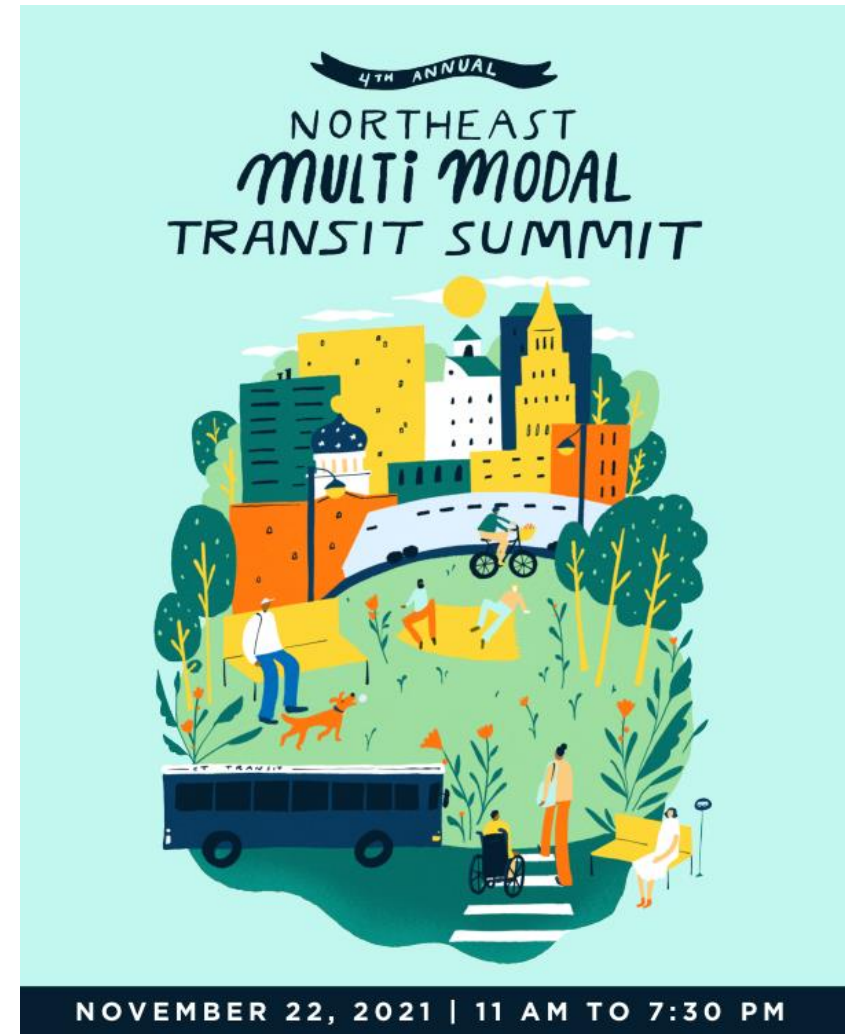

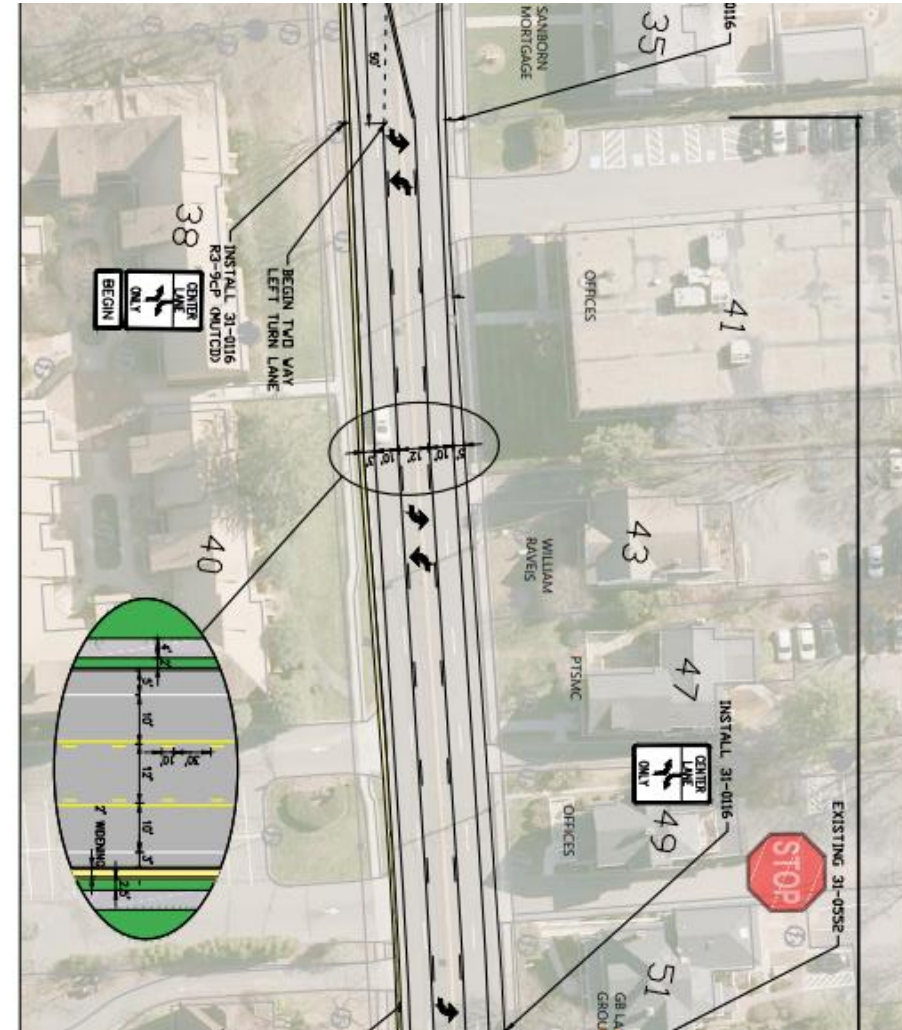
North Main Street Road Diet
