



CRPC #717 · INVITATION TO BID Bituminous Class 1, Class 2, and Curb Mix

Opportunity Q&A Answers

If this will be delivered what is the location of the delivery? Depending on the municipality, that information will be relayed once a contract is established between vendor and said city/town.

Where do we put pricing to differentiate picked-up vs. delivery? Per the bid specs, "All prices bid must be on the basis of F.O.B. delivery point, unloaded inside, unless otherwise indicated in the proposal. A bid on any other basis than that indicated in the proposal may be considered informal. Note: CRPC strictly prohibits the unilateral imposition of additional surcharges (fuel, delivery, etc.) on the participating communities at any point during the contract period. Prices bid shall apply throughout the term of the contract and will be construed as all-inclusive. No delivery shall become due or be acceptable without a written order issued by the Member Agency concerned. Such order will contain the quantity, time of delivery and other important data."

Is this bid intended to be FOB? The technical specifications reference a recommended thickness. Per the bid specs, "All prices bid must be on the basis of F.O.B. delivery point, unloaded inside, unless otherwise indicated in the proposal. A bid on any other basis than that indicated in the proposal may be considered informal. Note: CRPC strictly prohibits the unilateral imposition of additional surcharges (fuel, delivery, etc.) on the participating communities at any point during the contract period. Prices bid shall apply throughout the term of the contract and will be construed as all-inclusive."

Scope of services references delivery. This being a perishable product is the intent of this bid to deliver asphalt? Per the bid specs, "All prices bid must be on the basis of F.O.B. delivery point, unloaded inside, unless otherwise indicated in the proposal. A bid on any other basis than that indicated in the proposal may be considered informal. Note: CRPC strictly prohibits the unilateral imposition of additional surcharges (fuel, delivery, etc.) on the participating communities at any point during the contract period. Prices bid shall apply throughout the term of the contract and will be construed as all-inclusive."

Is there liquid escalation on this bid due to the volatility of liquid asphalt? Depending on the product, there may be increases that are calculated quarterly for some bituminous products.
