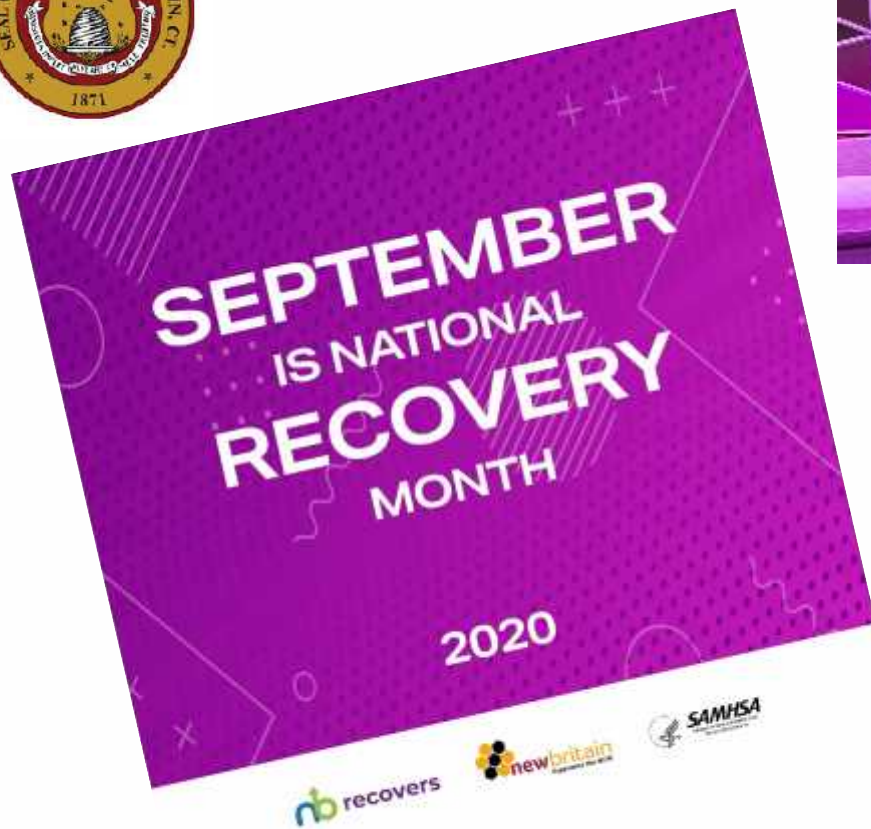

Recovery Navigator Program Launches Feb. 2021



- ▶ Core Rapid Referral Network Partners contracted in
- ▶ Data Summary
 - ▶ 313 referrals (85% internal 15% external)
 - ▶ 286 Patients (91%)
 - ▶ 186 enrolled into program
 - ▶ 96 engaged in treatment
- ▶ MOBILE response Team
 - ▶ 90% follow up with patients and Families within 48 hours of 911 call
