

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CRCOG TO COMMISSION A BIKE SHARE FEASIBILITY STUDY UPDATE

WHEREAS, the CRCOG developed a bike share feasibility study in 2014; and

WHEREAS, CRCOG held an RFP for a regional bike share program in 2019; and

WHEREAS, that program was never fully implemented due to COVID-19; and

WHEREAS, CRCOG towns have expressed interest in continuing to pursue a region wide bike share model.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Agency's Executive Director Lyle D. Wray, is authorized to commission a bike share feasibility study, expending up to \$50,000 of agency funds, and to act on behalf of the Capitol Region Council of Governments in negotiating, executing, and amending all appropriate and necessary contractual instruments or Memoranda of Understandings.
