Subject: 2023 LOTCIP Project Solicitation: DRAFT Schedule and Funding Allocations


A Cost Review Sub-Committee meeting will take place at 11:00 am on Monday, June 27, 2022. At the May meeting, Transportation Committee endorsed the goal of always maintaining at least one year's worth of LOTCIP (\$19 million) overprogramming. To meet that goal, this memo provides recommendations for upcoming solicitations timeframes and amounts, the resulting projected LOTCIP financials, and a DRAFT Schedule and Funding Allocations for a potential 2023 LOTCIP Solicitation.

Currently, staff is proposing a FY2023 solicitation of approximately \$25 million in LOTCIP projects. This solicitation, along with an envisioned \$43 million solicitation in FY2024, would maintain programming of at least an additional year of funding beyond what is budgeted. As shown in the chart and graph below, these solicitations are expected to bring LOTCIP financials **to overprogramming of \$14 million in July 2023, \$39 million in July 2024, and \$20 million in FY25**.

The financial projections are noted below:
