

#### **Assessment Benchmarking**



Background: Interest from the governor's office regarding regionalization of assessment offices



Benchmarking: CRCOG conducted two surveys to get a better understanding of the current state of the region's assessment offices

Survey 1: December 2019

**Topics:** 

-staffing

-appeals process



Survey 2: September 2021 to February 2022

Topics:

- -frequency of revaluations
- -assessment process
- -use of vendors & software



#### Assessment Overview

- 28 out of 38 towns responded to Survey 1
- 34 out of 38 towns responded to Survey 2

Average FTE: 3.3/town Average Full-time work week: 35 hours


- Hartford has the largest percentage of personal property assessments (20%)
- Windsor Locks has the largest percentage of motor vehicle assessments (15%)

#### Grand List Analysis


- Real estate assessments make up about 83% of the region's total net grand list
- Motor vehicle assessments make up 10%
- Personal property assessments make up 7%


#### **Grand List Composition by Town**




#### **Total Grand List by Town**

<sup>\*</sup>On average, the size of the assessor's office can be predicted by the municipality's population. However, population is not an indicator of the municipality's total grand list

#### Motor Vehicle Assessments








Motor vehicle assessments are conducted annually by municipalities Most towns use a combination of purchase books and online information to determine retail value

Municipalities receive an average of 30 motor vehicle appeals each year

#### **Use of Software**

- Over 80% of CRCOG municipalities use CAMA software
- Many towns reported using vendors for field work, tax preparation, billing, & collection

#### Office Accessibility to Public









Average Office Hours: Monday to Friday 8:00am to 4:30pm Most assessment offices close early on Fridays and are open late at least one day a week

All municipalities surveyed allow walk-in appointments.

73% of offices are available to the public through both walk-in and scheduled appointments.

#### Recommendations

1. Standardization of CAMA software across the region

2. Realign revaluation cycles

3. Standardize motor vehicle assessment across the state



- Improve efficiency
- Streamline the type of information collected and how it is collected



- Gain a better understanding of costs and methods used by municipalities
- Reveal the impact of revaluation on the number of appeals



- Simplify the motor vehicle assessment process
- Reduce time and labor in local assessment offices
