- Eric Anderson (Andover)
 - Ready to sign contract for connectivity grant project at Route 6 and Long Hill
 - Installed a temporary small traffic circle on Lake Road to get feedback from residents
- Sandy Fry (Hartford)
 - This is her last meeting as she is retiring
 - Working to get Community Connectivity Grant Program project in place. Involves a lot of bike lanes
 - Complete streets plan will be adopted next week
 - Will be doing "slow streets" (formerly bike boulevards) on an additional three streets in the coming months
- Chris Squires
 - Need a transportation study on Main Street from Town Hall to Goodwin University
 - Mayor is looking for grants to do something with the multi-use trail system
- Michele Lipe (South Windsor)
 - Moving forward with cross town trail (power line corridor)
 - Working on design
 - Community connections sidewalk program along Clark Street and Pleasant Valley Road
 - Evergreen walk moving forward with projects and installing sidewalks
 - Seeing increased interest in sidewalks
- Patrice Carson (Bolton)
 - Working on Community Connectivity Grant Program: Bolton center road connects past town hall
- Bob Dickinson
 - Some reconstruction on Buckland Road. Hoping for some road calming.
- Peter Gillespie (Wethersfield)
 - Heritage way bike path was designated as a CT greenway
 - Initiated a new event in Old Wethersfield; bicycles on main street
 - Wrapping up negotiations for maintenance for the Putnam Bridge Trail
 - Finishing design on LOTCIP project on Wolcott Hill Road
 - Finalizing Community Connectivity Grant Program improvements in Old Wethersfield
- Thomas Lefebvre (Transport Hartford)
 - Took part in a walk audit in South Windsor
 - Transportation Climate Initiative was removed from budget talks
 - Pressing for legislation that would define e-bikes as e-vehicles for rebate purposes
 - Wethersfield bicycle swap event coming up this weekend or next weekend
