 - Connects to Stanley Loop
 - Bee-line trail to west main street is funded and starting design
 - Health department gave a grant for bike education and bike racks
 - Bike New Britain shop has been busy
- Bike Wheel Ways South Windsor
 - Updating sidewalk plan with town engineer and planner
 - Bid for design of cross-town trail; selecting consultant
- Farmington
 - Working on amenities for trails such as water fountains and port-a-potties
 - Looking into shared routes to get people from trails to town centers
- Bolton
 - The town is working on a Community Connectivity from the elementary school to Main Street (town hall) and down to the Rochambeau trail
- BiCiCo/Transport Hartford
 - o Multimodal and transit summit finished
 - City completed first "slow street" on Hampton
 - Walk and bike audit training on November 17. recording of training is available.
