What is ezIQC?

When to use

- On-call contractors for maintenance, repair, upgrades, and small- to medium-sized projects.




How does it work?

PROCUREMENT PROCESS

- Contractors are competitively bid by service region. CRCOG towns are currently served by Martin Laveiro, BMP Construction Inc, or Hemlock Construction for roads and bridges depending on area.
- Pricing is provided by a standard "task catalog" which is competitively awarded upfront, saving time on bidding individual projects.
- Gordian works with you to conduct a full scope review and provide a quote to fit your project and budget needs.



Joint Scope Meeting

Once project information is received, Gordian will contact you to schedule a Joint Scope Meeting at the site to help you and the contractor agree on the details of the work to be performed. This meeting allows the contractor to inspect the site and ask questions before submitting a Price Proposal, helping to eliminate misunderstandings and mistakes. This upfront, open communication often results in more cost-effective. collaborative solutions

Detailed Scope of Work

Gordian helps you prepare a
Detailed Scope of Work that
describes the work the
contractor will perform. The
Detailed Scope of Work will be
sent along with the Request for
Proposal to the contractor.

Price Proposal

The contractor prepares a Price
Proposal by selecting the
appropriate tasks from
Gordian's Construction Task
Catalog® (CTC). The contractor
submits the Price Proposal
along with a construction
schedule and list of proposed
local contractors.

Price Proposal Review

Gordian reviews the Price
Proposal to ensure the
contractor has selected the
appropriate tasks and
quantities and will ask the
contractor to make any
required changes. The reviewed
Price Proposal is submitted for
your final review.

Purchase Order Issued

Once you are 100 percent satisfied with the Price Proposal, construction schedule, proposed subcontractors and have received and approved any other required documents (e.g. bonds, certificates of insurance, etc.), you can issue a purchase order for the contractor to proceed.



Transportation ezIQC in CT

Examples of Work

- Norwich: bridge repair traditional estimate \$250,000 with CT DOT; ezIQC completed for \$70,000 with alternate design from contractor
- Danbury: bridge replacement design and cost proposal, work to be completed this summer
- Small, quick jobs:
 - Installations of RRFB's, done quickly with a reputable contractor
 - Guide rail repairs (updates or accident repair)
