The Regional Long-Term Recovery Steering Committee is meeting on a monthly basis. In addition, working groups will also be meeting to coordinate recovery needs.

The Human Services Working Committee is now meeting monthly, and the small business economic recovery working group is also meeting monthly.

CRPC Bid Activities (Kim Bona)

June:

- The bid for treated road salt quantities was issued on June 8th and closes on June 24th.
- A contract between Bay State Textiles and CRCOG for textile collection and recycling services is currently being negotiated.

Upcoming Activities:

CRPC will issue the bid for Snow Plow Blades and Supplies on June 24th. The bid will close on July 13th.

Energy Consortium (Kim Bona)

The reverse auction took place on November 19th. MP2 was the lowest supplier with an extremely competitive rate and almost 20% savings. Municipalities may still be able to piggy-back on this auction and should contact Kim Bona.

NOVUS demonstrated a pilot program at the May 18th Municipal Services Meeting that was received favorably. The Policy Board authorized funding for this program at its May 26th meeting. CRCOG will move forward with this portal.

Electronic Document Management Services (EDMS) (Pauline Yoder)

EDMS has entered into program mode.

Regional Geographic Information System (GIS) (Erik Snowden)

- CRCOG IT/GIS now serves on the CT GIS Task Force. This group includes state legislators and is focused on championing and developing state GIS infrastructure and leadership. The work of this group has resulted in a bill that has made it through committee (vote yest to occur) and the identification of funding sources for a statewide flyover in the near future.
- Installation of CAMA data processors continues.
- CRCOG GIS staff are developing 3D building data using lidar data from the CRCOG-managed 2016 flight. This data will be used as an input to scenario planning efforts.

Solid Waste Management (Kim Bona or Pauline Yoder)

Discussion regarding the municipal solid waste issue continues among municipal leaders, CRCOG, CCSWA. The solid waste subcommittee met on June 17th. A tentative meeting with Tom Kirk is being scheduled for June 30th at 2:30pm.

The RFP for Textile Collection and Recycling was awarded to Bay State Textiles and a contract is currently being negotiated.

Crumbling Foundations: Requests for Qualifications (Kim Bona)

Current RFVQ's are being accepted and will close on June 30th.
