CRPC Bid Activities (Kim Bona)

January:

- CRPC is currently collecting quantities for fuel oil. Quantities are due on January 13th. Please note, Fuel Oil is one of the bids that does not allow piggy-backing
- Grass Seed and Fertilizer bids were issued to vendors on January 4th and will be opened on January 29th.

Upcoming Activities:

• CRPC will begin collecting quantities for Swimming Pool and Water Treatment Chemicals and Bituminous Class 2, Class 2 and Curb Mix in mid-January.
