- CRPC is currently collecting quantities for Swimming Pool Chemicals/Water Treatment and Bituminous Class 1 and 2 Curb Mix. **Quantities are due tomorrow, February 17**th.
- Fuel bid was issued to vendors on January 27th and will be opened tomorrow, February 17^{th.}

Upcoming Activities:

CRPC will begin collecting quantities for Treated Road Salt in May.

Regional Geographic Information System (GIS) (Erik Snowden)

- CRCOG IT/GIS now serves on the CT GIS Task Force. This group includes state legislators and is
 focused on championing and developing state GIS infrastructure and leadership. CRCOG GIS
 Coordinator is heading a working group that has collected data on the GIS capabilities of state,
 university, utility and regional entities. This data is being synthesized into a summary document
 to present to the legislature. Work on the document as well as cost estimates continues
 after a meeting with staff from the Office of the Governor.
- CRCOG GIS staff and CAI Technologies has completed the FY 2021 annual parcel data collection.
- Installation of CAMA data processors continues.
