Regarding the car tax item that has been of interest to the Policy Board, the Chair of the Appropriations Committee has expressed concern over funding and whether unforeseen fiscal problems might cause the monies to be withdrawn.

Lastly, while several ad-hoc meetings have taken place, a full budget meeting with OPM and the Governor's staff have not yet taken place.

7. PRESENTATION/UPDATES

a. DataHaven - Kelly Davila, Senior Research Associate

Kelly Davila, Senior Research Associate at DataHaven, reported on the results of a Community Wellbeing Survey conducted in the Greater Hartford area. The survey was conducted during 2021, specifically after the COVID-19 vaccines became available to adults 18+ in the state of Connecticut. Ms. Davila shared with the Policy Board several statistics related to community wellbeing, including pandemic related hardships, outlook on economic opportunities, safety, discrimination, health and healthcare, COVID-19 vaccination status, and more.
