1. Welcome and Introductions

Chairperson Jennifer Bartiss-Early welcomed everyone.

2. Adoption of Minutes: June 11, 2020

3. Memo and Presentation: CTDOT – Greater Hartford Mobility Study

Mike Calabrese, CTDOT, introduced Casey Harden, VP of TranSystems. Casey Harden presented to the commission on the Greater Hartford Mobility Study. A discussion followed. In response to quesions, Casey Hardin said post-COVID remote work patterns, employer incentives to use transit, and structural issues with the I-84 viaduct would be considered.

5. Report on Zoning and Subdividsion Referrals

6. What's New in My Town? A Discussion and Report on Local Planning and Development Activities in the Municipalities of the Capitol Region

Plainville - No update.

Windsor – Steel erection of Amazon distrcit center. Great Pond Development in phase three. Planning is taking place on soccer dome site.

Manchester – PZC gave positive referral to Town Board of Directors to sell rear of parkade to developer. Plans should be available in November.

Canton – Approved zoning map expansion for one of the village districts. Working on moving forward with updated regulations for towers and antenaes. Updated POCD implementation section. Working on affordable housing plan for community.

Avon - Two regulatory changes considered re: at-home workplace, and accessory unitsboth attached and detached units.

Bolton – Extended permission for outdoor dining until November 2021.

7. Other Business

Jennifer Bartiss-Early and Lynne Pike DiSanto asked commission members for thoughts and requests for future meeting presentations and discussion.

Topics included:

- Public safety issues associated with outdoor dining provisions during Covid.
- Trends related to Aging in Place and associated issues with access to health care and other services.
- Efforts by DesegregateCT to promote changes to land use regulations

Discussion followed and Commission members expressed a preference for a presentation on Desgregate CT at the November meeting. Staff proposed to research the other topics for future presentations.
