

AUTHORIZING RESOLUTION

FOR EXECUTION OF AN AGREEMENT WITH WSP FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF A TOD ROLES, VISIONING, VIABILITY & TOOLS ANALYSIS STUDY

WHEREAS, the Capitol Region Council of Governments (CRCOG), as the Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) for the Hartford metropolitan area, is required by federal regulations to conduct a continuing and comprehensive transportation planning program, and

WHEREAS, the Federal Highway Administration and the Federal Transit Administration provide funds for CRCOG to conduct such a program, and

WHEREAS, the federal funds are made available through the Connecticut Department of Transportation, and

WHEREAS, CRCOG identified the development of a Transit-Oriented Development (TOD) Roles, Visioning, Viability & Tools Analysis study within its Unified Planning Work Program (UPWP) for FY2022-2023, and

WHEREAS, CRCOG has conducted a qualifications-based selection process and found the consulting firm WSP to be the most qualified firm to assist CRCOG in the development of a TOD Roles, Visioning, Viability & Tools Analysis study;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT, that CRCOG's Executive Director, Lyle D. Wray, is authorized to act on behalf of the Capitol Region Council of Governments in negotiating, executing, and amending all appropriate and necessary contractual instruments with the consulting firm WSP for the purpose of developing a TOD Roles, Visioning, Viability & Tools Analysis Study.
