

Position Announcement - GIS Analyst


Come join our team! The Capitol Region Council of Governments is seeking a dynamic, collaborative, and visionary professional to serve as its GIS Analyst. The GIS Analyst will perform a variety of Geographic Information System (GIS) and data analysis tasks within the Administration and Municipal Services Department. This position reports to the GIS and IT Manager.

This position is responsible for updating and maintaining regional GIS databases, preparing digital, printed and web maps, and geographic analysis for all CRCOG planning functions. Typical assignments may include (but are not limited to) performing annual updates to regional GIS datasets; providing both static and web mapping products, as well as geographic and other data analysis for all CRCOG departments.

The successful candidate will hold a bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university with a major in Geography, Data Analysis, Computer Science or a closely related field and one to three years of increasingly responsible experience or a combination of training and work experience that demonstrates the knowledge and ability to perform required duties as well as experience using ESRI software products including ArcGIS Pro and ArcGIS Online. Knowledge and experience using Python scripting in GIS is also a plus. In addition, the successful candidate will have knowledge of Microsoft Office and/or Microsoft 365; and basic hardware and software troubleshooting. Candidates must have the ability to: work with municipal staff to collect parcel, land use, and zoning data for updates; perform routine GIS data maintenance tasks; create online maps and applications using ArcGIS Online and ArcGIS Enterprise sites; communicate clearly and effectively orally and in writing; prepare clear, accurate records and reports; establish and maintain highly effective working relationships with managers, and municipal staff and others encountered during work; organize, coordinate, and prioritize multiple project assignments; handle multiple projects simultaneously; and use good judgment in prioritizing work assignments.
