5. Legislative Update

Kathie Lutz stated that yesterday, a special session was held regarding an election monitor in Bridgeport and a proposal to align municipal election dates; however, this proposal did not affect CRCOG towns. Additionally, it was noted that next year's session will only be three months long. Finally, Lutz offered to assist members who wish to join the CRCOG Legislative Committee.

7. Presentation and Resolution for adoption of the update to the comprehensive economic development strategy (CEDS).

Jon Colman moved for approval for the CEDS Report; Lori Spielman seconded. The presentation highlighted the report which is a coordinated list of actions that entities and organizations agree to take to create economic prosperity in the Capitol Region.  Cheryl Assis presented the annual resolution for Matt Hart to submit the FY 2023 Homeland Security Grant Program application and enter into a Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) with each Region 3 community. Steve Jones made a motion to approve the proposed budget and

C.J. Thomas seconded. The motion passed unanimously.

10. Approval of the FY 2022-2023 Regional Services Grant Spending Report.

Pauline Yoder presented the annual report that is sent to the Office of Policy and Management (OPM) which covers everything that CRCOG does with the Regional Services Grant. 11. Resolution Authorizing Execution of MOU Between CRCOG and CCSWA for Administrative Support.

recoup funds spent for CCSWA. Fred Presley made a motion to approve, and C.J. Thomas seconded. The motion passed unanimously.

12. Resolution Authorizing Execution of an Agreement with Ecointeractive for eTIP/LOTCIP Management Software.

Cara Radzins presented a resolution for CRCOG to enter into an agreement with ETIP to use their program management software for LOTCIP and TIP programs. David Nagel made a motion to approve & Lori Spielman seconded. The motion passed unanimously.

The report has already been approved by the Transportation Committee unanimously. Dave Nagel made a motion to approve, and C.J. Thomas seconded. The motion passed unanimously.

Radzins recommended approval of the Authorizing Resolution for Execution of Agreements for the USDOT 2022 Safe Streets and Roads for all Grant Awarded to CRCOG. Erika Wiecenski made a motion for approval Steve Jobes seconded the motion.
