1. Call to Order

Lori Spielman called meeting to order at 12:04 PM

2. Public Comment

3. Approval of Minutes from October 11, 2023

5. Legislative Update

Chris Smith presented an overview of the FY 2023 budget and gave a preview of the upcoming 2024 mid-term session, which will address adjustments to the adopted budget. During short sessions, legislators will be limited to submitting budget-related bills only. The Governor is expected to release budget adjustments in the first week of February, and hearings will begin immediately. After the session ends, the election season for the General Assembly will begin. Statewide officers will not be on the ballot next fall. (Information regarding state budget balances can be found at the 59-minute mark.)

7. Approval of CRCOG Vision Zero Task Force Charter

Roger Krahn presented the proposed Vision Zero Task Force. The task force will be responsible for working with CRCOG staff to update and implement the Regional Transportation Safety Plan. Jon Colman reported that the Transportation Committee has endorsed the Charter and made a motion to approve. Peter Souza seconded and the motion passed unanimously.

8. Approval of 2024 Executive Committee and Policy Board Meeting Dates

Matt Hart requested approval of the 2024 meetings schedule. Jon Colman moved approval of both schedules. Peter Souza seconded. The motion passed unanimously.

9. Appointment of Nominating Committee (CRCOG bylaws pg.21)

Matt Hart explained that Jon Colman will chair the nominating committee and is seeking additional volunteers. Matt Hart noted that a quorum was no longer sustained. Toni Moran and Lori Spielman volunteered to join the committee.
