Subject: Resolution Authorizing Agreement with the National Association of City and

County Health Officials (NACCHO)

Background: CRCOG has received Operational Readiness Awards from NACCHO over the years to sustain, train, and equip the Capitol Region Medical Reserve Corps (CR-MRC). This award will include funds for the CR-MRC Logistics Unit Leader and Trainer to facilitate a mission ready logistics support team.

Benefit to Member Towns/CRCOG: This funding will serve to keep the CR-MRC operational as an asset to all CRCOG member communities.

<u>Financial/Operational Impact:</u> This award is for \$10,000 and is funded by the National Association of City and County Health Officials. CRCOG is not expected to provide any matching funds and will receive \$1,000 (10%) to manage the grant.

Project Schedule: The grant funds will be made available on May 3, 2024, with a performance period of one year.

Recommendation: In order to receive these grant funds, I respectfully request and recommend that the Policy Board act favorably upon this resolution.

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AGREEMENT WITH THE NATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF COUNTY AND CITY HEALTH OFFICIALS (NACCHO)

WHEREAS, NACCHO has received a grant from the Department of Health and Human Services Office of the Assistant Secretary of Preparedness and Response to build the capacity of local Medical Reserve Corps ("MRC") units and provide 2024 Operational Readiness Awards; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the terms of the Grant, NACCHO has agreed to provide funding support to local MRC units that are registered in good standing with the MRC Program Office; and

WHEREAS, CRCOG recently submitted an application to NACCHO in the maximum amount of \$10,000 to build the operational readiness capabilities of volunteers in the Capitol Region Medical Reserve Corps (CR-MRC) and to strengthen our current capabilities for evolving response missions; and

WHEREAS, this application will include funds for the CR-MRC Logistics Unit Leader and Trainer to continue facilitating a mission ready logistics support team; and

WHEREAS, the CRCOG application has been approved by NACCHO; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that that the CRCOG Policy Board authorize the Executive Director to sign an agreement with NACCHO and any addendums thereto and accept grant funds for the purposes outlined above.
