• Crumbling Foundations – Implications of Remediation on Grand Lists (Matt Hart, Pauline Yoder)

CRCOG will be conducting an analysis for the grand list implications of remediation through the crumbling foundations program. Connecticut Foundation Solutions Indemnity Company (CFSIC) principal, Michael Maglaras gave a presentation on CFSIC's work to date. Mr. Maglaras stated that CFSIC estimates an additional \$100 million would be needed to remediate the remaining homes in addition to the currently allocated amounts.
