1. Call to Order

Chairperson Jennifer Bartiss-Earley called the meeting to order at 7:05pm.

2. Adoption of Minutes: November 16, 2023

Motion to approve the minutes of November 16, 2023, as presented made by Bill Rice. Second to the motion provided by Tom Manning; it was carried unanimously with Lisa Levin and Christine Sinopoli abstaining.

3. Report on the Regional Plan of Conservation and Development (POCD) Update

CRCOG staff delivered the presentation on the Regional POCD at 22 minutes into the recording. Tom Manning motions and Gia Pascarelli seconds the motion to extend the 2014 Regional Plan of Conservation and Development to serve as the regional plan for referrals until November of 2024. Bonnie Potocki points out that the reasoning for the extension should be included on the record: Except for graphic design, CRCOG determined it would prepare the POCD in-house, relying on staff availability to complete the plan by May 2024. Since that decision was made, there was almost complete turnover of project staff. In addition, CRCOG was awarded grant funding for other projects which had short timeframes and diverted staff from the POCD in December 2023 and January 2024 - key months in completing a full draft to keep us on schedule. Staff met with the RPC Chair and Vice Chair in February to alert them to the delay and determine a timeframe to move forward as expeditiously as possible while still meeting state notice requirements and providing adequate time for review by the RPC and the Technical Advisory Committee. State statutes do not identify consequences for a delayed adoption of a plan and staff discussed how it could continue to use the 2014 plan in the interim for referrals.

4. Report on Zoning and Subdivision Referrals

Jacob Knowlton reviewed recent zoning and subdivision referrals and existing trends. This can be found at the time 1:40:00 in the recording.
