1. Call to Order

Lori Spielman called meeting to order at 12:03 PM

2. Public Comment

3. Approval of Minutes from February 28, 2024

Jon Colman made a motion to approve the minutes of February 28, 2024 as presented. Lori Spielman seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

5. Legislative Update

The CRCOG Legislative Ad-hoc committee has focused on prioritizing certain bills, including HB 5056, SB 375, HB 5048, HB 5278, HB 5390, HB 5391, SB 198, as well as the Motor Vehicle and Housing Bills. John Harkins pointed out that HB 5056 underwent meaningful language changes. The Comptroller provided an update on the state budget, reporting a surplus, but there has been an increased demand for spending on non-profits and education. Harkins mentioned that most committees have already met, and the session is set to be closed during the week of April 8th. Furthermore, it was noted that the Insurance Committee missed their deadline, and Senator Kelly has been replaced with Senator Harding as the new leader of the Republican caucus.

Authorizing Resolution: Execution of Agreements for Administration of the Local Transportation Capital Improvement Program: Jon Colman recommend approval to negotiate and contract with the two firms, BETA and CHA, for a 48-month duration for LOTCIP program management and design reviews. The Transportation Committee provided a recommendation at the March 25, 2024 meeting. Jon Colman made a motion to approve, and Eric Anderson seconded. Motion passed.
- 8. Resolution in support of CRCOG/Green Bank Application for Climate Pollution Reduction Grant Implementation Funding: Matt Hart, Kyle Shiel, and Mackey Dykes of the Connecticut Greenbank presented the items and recommended the Policy Board endorse the coalition application for CPRG Implementation funding. The presentation can be found at 42 minutes. Jon Colman made a motion to approve, Eric Anderson seconded. Motion passed.
- 9. Resolution authorizing agreement with All Clear Emergency
 Management Group: Cheryl Assis recommended the Board's approval to accept
 funds from All Clear Emergency Management Group in the amount of \$8,240 to
 administer for the Capitol Region Medical Reserve Corps. Jon Colman made a motion to
 approve, and Marc Nelson seconded. Motion passed.
