### Capitol Region Transportation Improvement Program (TIP)

The Capitol Region Council of Governments (CRCOG) is preparing its Transportation Improvement Program (TIP), a list of transportation projects that will receive federal funds in the next four years, and the associated Air Quality Conformity Analysis (AQCA). These draft documents are available for a public comment period from 4/3/2024 to 5/6/2024 with hybrid (in-person or virtual) public meetings on 4/24/2024 at 11am and 7pm.

This notice of public involvement activities and time established for public review and comments on the TIP development process will satisfy the Federal Transit Administration's (FTA) Program of Projects (POP) requirements for proposed transit improvements. The POP is the equivalent of the transit element of the TIP.

The State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) is also available for review. Hybrid public meetings on the STIP are scheduled for 5/15/2024 at 1pm and 7pm.
